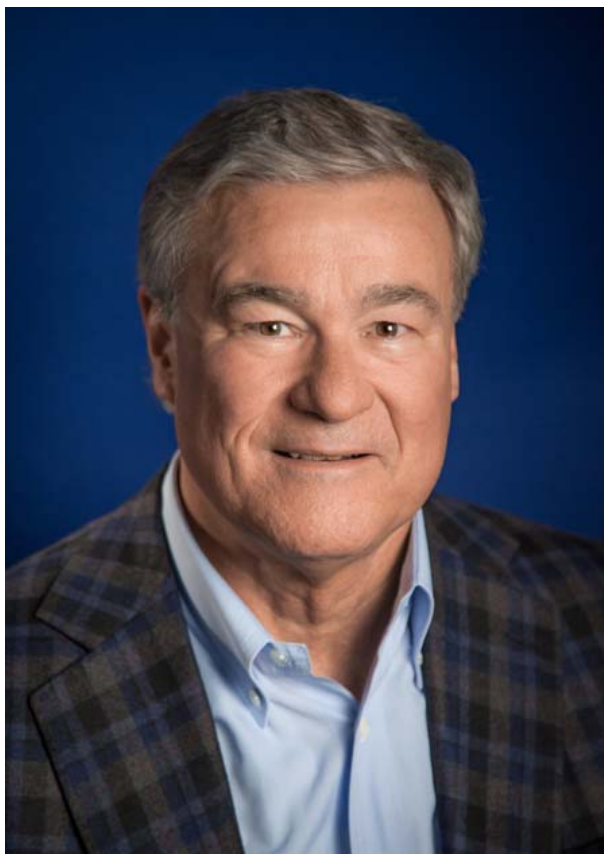


**Trevor D. Rees-Jones '69**

Trevor entered the oil and gas business in 1984. By 2005 his company, Chief Oil & Gas, was the second largest producer in the Barnett Shale. From 2006 to 2012 he sold significant positions in shale acreage and production, but continues to operate over 200,000 acres of leases in the Marcellus Shale in Pennsylvania. Chief currently produces over 1% of the nation's natural gas supply. He and his wife, Jan, established the Rees-Jones Foundation in 2006. Since its inception the foundation has made more than 1,000 grants totaling more than \$250 million to not for profit groups focusing on human services for children, youth development, mental health and community benefit. He is past president of the Dallas Petroleum Club, served on the Board of Trustees of Dartmouth College and is currently a Trustee at TCU. He has received the Folsom Award for community service, been chosen for the Junior Achievement Business Hall of Fame, and most recently inducted into the Texas Business Hall of Fame.
